**Council Member wants to Catch Tallmadge Recycling!**



The Summit/Akron Solid Waste Management Authority's (SASWMA) Green Team is partnering with the City of Tallmadge and Summit County Council Representative for District Six, Jerry Feeman, to be on the look out for loaded (with the correct recyclables) recycling bins.

When a loaded recycling bin is spotted curbside, SASWMA could place a large sticker on your recycling bin. Receiving a "Green Handed" sticker and gift card from one of SASWMA's Green Handed Partners, Gionino's Pizzeria and the Henry Bierce Company, means you have been "caught green handed."

"If you are recycling, great job! If you are not, call your waste hauler, which could be Republic Waste at-1-800-247-3644 or R&R Sanitation at 330.628-9609, and ask for a recycling bin," stated Mr. Feeman. You can recycle the following items - plastics #1 and #2, aluminum and steel cans, glass jars and bottles, newspaper and all other paper, paperboard (i.e. cereal boxes), and cardboard in your recycling bin. Recycling not only helps the environment, but you could benefit by being "Caught Green Handed" too!
