

**RENEWAL OF DECLARATION OF STATE OF EMERGENCY  
JUNE 15 – JULY 1, 2020  
FOR THE CITY OF TALLMADGE**

WHEREAS, on this 15<sup>th</sup> day of June, 2020, the Declaration of State of Emergency for the City of Tallmadge is hereby renewed for fifteen (15) additional days until the 1<sup>st</sup> day of July, or until the Mayor finds that the threat or danger has subsided to the extent that the emergency conditions no longer exist and the state of emergency is terminated by proclamation, or the state of emergency is renewed; and

WHEREAS the life, safety and welfare of the residents of the City of Tallmadge, Counties of Summit and Portage, State of Ohio, continue to be at risk due to the infectious respiratory disease identified as the Coronavirus disease (COVID-19); and

WHEREAS, all the conditions existing at the time of the Declaration of State of Emergency for the City of Tallmadge and the Renewal of Declaration of State of Emergency for the City of Tallmadge continue to exist and are incorporated by reference as if fully rewritten herein; and

WHEREAS, the President of the United States issued a Declaration of a State of Emergency on March 13, 2020; and


WHEREAS, the State of Ohio issued a Declaration of a State of Emergency on March 9, 2020. On March 22, 2020, the Ohio Department of Health Director issued a Stay at Home Order that was extended through May 1, 2020, and a Stay Safe Ohio Order that was issued through May 29, 2020, and variety of orders, including but not limited to, the Director's Updated and Revised Order for Business Guidance and Social Distancing that has been issued through July 1, 2020; and

WHEREAS, The County of Summit issued a Declaration of a State of Emergency on March 13, 2020. The County of Portage issued a Declaration of State of Emergency on March 19, 2020; and


WHEREAS, the City of Tallmadge must engage in coordinated efforts with the County, State and Federal government to the extent possible as well as coordinating efforts within its borders.

NOW THEREFORE, I, David G. Kline, Mayor of the City of Tallmadge declare that a state of emergency continues to exist in the City and hereby renew the Declaration of State of Emergency for the City of Tallmadge through July 1, 2020, and invoke and declare those portions of the Ohio Revised Code and Tallmadge Codified Ordinances which are applicable to the conditions that have caused the renewal of this declaration, which is incorporated by reference to the Declaration of State of Emergency for the City of Tallmadge as if fully rewritten herein, to continue to be in full force and effect in the City for the exercise of all necessary emergency authority for the life, safety and welfare of the residents of Tallmadge.
