## Requirements & Guidelines for League Division Choice:

- **Rosters will be limited to 12 players per team.**
- **Only 12 spectators per team permitted for youth leagues. No spectators permitted for adult leagues.**
- Age for all leagues will be determined as of 12/31/20 for Session I & 12/31/2021 for Session II  
*Example: If the player turns 12 years of age during the year 2021, they must play in the U-14 division.*
- Youth players may play up a division, but are not permitted to play down a division. No youth player may play up more than 2 years of their actual age.
- High school divisions - No older than HS Senior & younger than U14 may play in this league. Teams must always have a Concussion and Lindsay's Law certified parent coach on the bench.

**Arrival and Departure:**

- Prior to coming to the game, all players, spectators, coaches, and referees must perform a symptom check and should not attend if they exhibit any symptoms of COVID-19.
- Teams and spectators will not be permitted to enter the facility until 10 minutes before the start their scheduled game.
- All spectators and teams will be asked to follow signage in the building directing them down the soccer hallway to the field entrance or through concessions to the stairs to access the bleachers.
- Teams and spectators must exit the facility immediately upon conclusion of the game.

**Masks:**

- Coaches and spectators must wear masks at all times.
- Players and referees must wear masks throughout the facility, while seated on the bench and during breaks in the game but are not required to wear masks if they are actively playing in or refereeing the game.

**Teams, coaches, and referees:**

- Coaches of youth teams must take COVID-19 education from ODH and must educate their players, parents, and assistant coaches on this information prior to the start of the season.
- Rosters will be limited to 12 players per team.
- Teams will still provide the ball and it will be sanitized prior to the game and at half time.
- Players may bring water, but each must have their own bottle.
- Players must distance as much as possible while in the player box.
- Locker rooms will be closed. Players should come dressed to play.

**Spectators:**

- Only 1 spectator per player will be permitted for youth leagues.
- No spectators will be permitted for adult leagues.
- Spectators must sit in marked areas of the bleachers to maintain social distancing and must remain in their seats throughout the game.

**Other notes:**

- Games will be scheduled one hour and 15 minutes apart.
- After each game, the bleachers and benches will be sanitized before allowing the next team to enter. All high-touch areas will be sanitized on their current regular schedule.
- Water fountains, bottle filling stations and the concessions stand will remain closed.
